Block 949 Cabernet Sauvignon, Knights Valley, 2009

94% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Merlot and 2% Petit Verdot, fermented using pump-over and aged 20 months in 100% American oak barrels (50% new).

Deep-purple-red in color, dry, medium full-bodied with balanced acidity and quite chewy phenolics. Supple, ripe, dark red and black fruit (cherry-berry-plum) offering tobacco, black pepper, cocoa powder and dark spice with gravelly terroir and notes of both French and American oak. Picks up the flavors of black pepper and grilling from foods. Plenty of richness. Great with grilled steaks. Opens nicely in the glass. Easy to drink. Spec's Score: 91.
