LINDSEY

Kostritzer Schwarzbier

4.8% ABV, Schwarzbier/German Black Lager Available in 6 packs

Kostritzer is surprisingly dark, but at the same time has a surprisingly light finish. The body is almost jet black with a ruby shimmer when held to the light. Sweet and roasted malt are the most prominent aromas on the nose. When first sipped it has a wonderful malt flavor. But unlike porters and stouts, where the bitterness comes from the heavily roasted malt, Kostritzer gets its crisp finish from a nice dose of hops that is easily detected in the finish of this beer.

Corona Familiar

4.6% ABV, Pale Lager

A format finally available in Texas, Corona Familiar is similar in most ways to Corona Extra. The brown bottle keeps the beer from skunking, a characteristic all too familiar of Corona clear bottled beers. But because of the lack of skunking, the beer has fuller body and fresher taste. For those that love Corona Extra, Corona Familiar is worth the shot.

Oskar Blues Old Chub

8% ABV, Scottish Ale Available in 6 pack cans

Since 2002, Oskar Blues has been synonymous with great craft beer in a can. Old Chub Scottish Style Ale is a deep caramel colored beer with a fantastic creamy head. Old Chub is very malt forward on the tongue with notes of coffee, caramel and a hint of smokiness.
