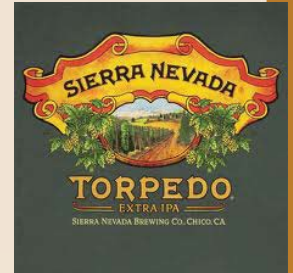
LINDSEY

Sierra Nevada Torpedo Extra IPA

7.2% ABV, American IPA

Torpedo was Sierra Nevada's first new year-round release since the 80's and over the past 2 years it is now the #1 selling IPA in America, a spot well deserved. Using the hop torpedo device (from which the beer gets its name) during the dry-hopping stage of the brew, they are able to deliver a purer, stronger hop aroma without the bitterness.

"With an awesome hop aroma and strong grapefruit, piney flavor, this is my go-to for a hop fix. There is just enough malt to carry the hop bitterness all the way through to the extra dry finish."

Shiner Ruby Redbird

4.2% ABV, Fruited Golden Lager

This summer Shiner has debuted their new seasonal beer, Ruby Redbird. It's an American Golden Lager brewed with South Texas Ruby Red grapefruit and ginger. The grapefruit adds a nice tartness to the body and the ginger gives the beer a nice, refreshing kick in the finish. With its outstanding drinkability, Shiner Ruby Redbird is the perfect choice for a summer beer.

Lagunitas Hop Stoopid

8% ABV, American Double/Imperial IPA

As the name suggests, Hop Stoopid is an aggressively hopped imperial IPA by Lagunitas. Hop Stoopid pours golden amber color with an impressive head. The beer starts with a citrus and sweet taste, but finishes with a strong piney bitterness. The 8% ABV is concealed nicely, giving it wonderful drinkability. This beer comes packaged in 22oz bottles only.
