Brooklyn Lager

5.2% ABV, American Amber Lager

Brooklyn Brewery beers are deep rooted in brewing tradition and Brooklyn Lager is no exception. Brewed using American amber malt, the body is a little maltier than typical American lagers. Then, using traditional British brewing techniques, the beer is dry hopped to create a crisp finish to complement the smooth, malty flavor.

Schlitz Gusto

4.7% ABV, American Adjunct Lager

After 40 years, Schlitz Brewing has reintroduced their original formula brew and brought back their once-revolutionary "Brown Glass" bottles. To recreate that flavor profile, the brewery sought out the input of former and retired employees from the era before the reformulation. The resulting beer still has the original full flavored, light bodied crispness as it did during the breweries hey-day.

Flying Dog Tire Bite Golden Ale

5.1% ABV, Kölsch

Kölsch beers originated in Germany, but several American craft breweries have made adaptations of the style. Tire Bite is Flying Dog Brewery's interpretation of this classic beer. It is a light bodied beer that is pale in color and has a great clean finish that Kölsch style beers are renowned for.
